

Woodland Weekends Pre-Arrival Information

Thank you for booking a with us. We look forward to welcoming you onto the farm for a restful stay.

Arrival information:

The postcode for the site is CO10 8RE. Being a rural location the postcode is not exact. As you arrive at the postcode you will be travelling either south (having passed through Stansfield), or north having passed through the majority of Poslingford.

- If travelling south
 - o About 1 mile after leaving Stansfield you will pass a sign for Poslingford. The turning is the next gateway on the left;
- If travelling north
 - o Pass through Poslingford (the village covers a large area so keep going through the main part of the village) heading towards Stansfield. You will see a new timber clad house on the left. The turning is opposite that house down a farm track.

The correct gateway has the discreet sign pictured below:



Please do not go down any other tracks as they are not suitable for small vehicles. If in doubt please give us a ring.

Follow the track past the 'private' sign until you reach the car park sign. Do not go beyond the car park in a car. The road is not suitable and we would like to keep cars away from the camping area.

Finding your pitch

We have two woodland camps, '**Shadowbush**' and '**Twixt**' (named after the wood and the nearest field). Once parked continue on foot along the track. The entrance to the wood is signed. There is a central ride through the wood.

Shadowbush is the first pitch you will come to. It is left by the rope swing shortly after entering the wood. We have cut a few spots for tents and there is a firepit provided. This is a lovely spot that gets good light during the day and the cut outs are ideal for those with a few tents.

Twixt is further into the wood. Carry on down the path (about 100m). There is a small sign and path to the camp. A firepit is provided. This camp is further into the wood and has a lot more tree cover. It probably lends itself to more extensive use of tarps.

The pitches are assigned on a first come basis. However, if you have a particular preference please get in touch prior to arrival and we will do our best to accommodate your request.

The map below gives a rough idea of the site layout.

Pitch Rules and Safety

Please use the portaloos located in 'Twixt Meadow'. If everyone uses the wood as their loo it does mount up over the course of a season!

Each camp has a few pitch sites to choose from but in the interest of preserving the rest of the wood please only camp with those areas.

We have provided fire pits for campfires. Please use these as it helps to protect the ground and also prevents spread of fire in dry conditions. You are welcome to source campfire wood from fallen branches within the wood.

The woods to the east of the meadow are in different ownership so please do not go in them. We have erected signs of where not to go in woods.

There are some high seats for our deer stalker. Please do not climb these as it is not safe.

The woods are a quiet place so please be respectful of others and refrain from being too noisy. Amplified music is not permitted.

Safety on the farm

Our farm is a busy place and there are often tractors moving around. Please stick to public footpaths. Please do not let dogs off leads they can harm livestock and it is very easy to lose them in the woods.
